### 20 Course Description:

The course introduces Chinese literature to students in general. Reading of various literary texts will be based on representative texts to familiarize students with literary terminology and the methods of text interpretation and make them realize the importance of general knowledge for literature. Students will learn to work in groups. Through their group discussions and short presentations about the materials which they study, i.e. a book compiled by Dr. Duan, they will display better cross-cultural communication skills via comparing different cultures.
