19 Course Description:

This course introduces the famous literary works in the ancient Chinese literatures, appreciates the characters they shaped, the scenes they depicted and the creative techniques they use through the selected texts. The Students should be able to read and appreciate the literary works and to utilize the acquired vocabulary expressions creative technique they learned from the works.
