Title: Loanwords in Jordanian Arabic
Loanwords in Jordan Arabic are distributed across a continuum from established loanwords that are part of the native language to instances of spontaneous codeswitching. The functions of these words in the spoken domain resemble, to some extent, the functions served in the written domain. In the spoken domain, English insertions act as an additional device to serve plenty of communicative functions, the most frequent ones are reiteration, humor, and message qualification.

In the written discourse, spontaneous codeswitches and established loanwords target the specificity of the meaning intended and act as persuasive devices that attract the attention of the readership to the writer's point of view. They were also used to reflect the writers' linguistic and scientific proficiency. The communicative functions identified in synchronous Facebook interactions match those identified in the written and spoken domains.
