Course Description

This course offers an up-to-date account of the main concerns, problems, theoretical and practical issues raised by foreign/ second language teaching and acquisition research. Students will be provided with a comprehensive review in this area of applied linguistics, along with a critical overview of the major approaches, questions and hypotheses in areas central to second language theory and practice. We will dedicate a good part of the course to a study of SLA research as it applies to classroom learning and instruction.

Upon completion of this course, students will be able to get a real understanding of the fundamental issues in the SLA field, of the advances that have been achieved by empirical research, and also of problems in SLA theories which have not yet been solved and sometimes not even approached.
