Title and abstract of the doctoral thesis (within 150 words)**Interprétations Universelles et Existentielles de 'Kull' en Arabe Jordanien: Théories et Expérimentation.**

Cette thèse explore trois interprétations possibles de *kull* en Arabe Jordanien (AJ): (i) l'interprétation de quantifieur universel (distributif/collectif), considérée comme l'interprétation standard dans la littérature; (ii) l'interprétation d'item de libre choix (également mentionnée par Fassi Fehri, 2020); (iii) l'interprétation d'item de polarité

négative. Ce faisant, cette thèse explore l'interprétation de *kull* dans une perspective tout à fait nouvelle, celle qu'ouvre les recherches de Levy (2008), Tonciulescu (2011) et Bar-Lev & Margulis (2014) sur l'interprétation de *kol* en hébreu, homologue étymologique de *kull* en arabe. Ces auteurs argumentent que *kol* permet des lectures existentielles et à ce titre doit être traité comme un indéfini (sans force quantificationnelle inhérente pour Levy, indéfini universel pour Tonciulescu, et quantifieur existentiel, avec une force universelle dans certains contextes pour Bar-Lev & Margulis). Nous défendons cette hypothèse pour *kull* en AJ en montrant que *kull* permet des lectures existentielles dans des contextes interrogatifs, négatifs (y compris des constructions existentielles négatives) et modaux, au même titre que son homologue en hébreu, mais seulement à condition de se combiner avec une restriction indéfinie singulière, jamais avec une restriction définie. La disponibilité des lectures permises en contexte négatif est, par ailleurs, empiriquement confirmée par la première étude expérimentale menée avec (51) locuteurs natifs de l'AJ pour explorer l'interprétation de *kull* enchâssé dans une île syntaxique, sous la portée de l'opérateur négatif *bidu:n ma* 'sans'.
