Languages at the Heart of Exile: Learning, Representations, Practices. The Case of Syrians in Zaatari Camp (Les langues au coeur de l'exil : apprentissage, représentations, pratiques. L'exemple des Syriens dans le camp de Zaatari).

This dissertation investigates language practices and representations among Syrian refugees in Jordan's Zaatari camp. It aims to understand their socio-linguistic reality to propose education strategies tailored to their language needs. Through microsociological interviews and drawings, it analyzes the camp's characteristics, language learning dynamics, and refugees' evolving language identities. It advocates for personalized education programs addressing trauma survivors' needs, and promotes a plurilingual and intercultural approach to foster empathy and academic resilience among refugees and humanitarian workers.
